## Student Technology Agreement 2007-08 School Year

Students may use school computers for academic purposes only. Any word processing, database, spreadsheet, presentation, desktop publishing or other files must be for the purpose of meeting curricular objectives. Students may use educational software provided on the network for the purpose of meeting curricular objectives, and consequently should choose to use only those programs that are appropriate to their academic level. Students in the Elementary I, Elementary II and Secondary I classes may use the Internet for academic research and for completing computer simulations and activities that meet curricular objectives only if they have permission from their parents. Secondary students may bring their personal laptops to school for personal use. They will not be permitted to share with other students. Any use of school computers or personal computers during school hours, for other purposes—including, but not limited to, sending and receiving e-mail; on-line chatting; and playing games other than those approved and assigned by school staff—is strictly prohibited. Students are not permitted to download or install software; to change any settings on computers or the network; or to adjust, repair or attempt to repair any software or hardware. Additionally, students may only access their own saved files. They are not to share access to their own files and passwords or to gain access to other students' or teachers' files or passwords. Students may use the Internet only with their parents' permission. While the school uses filtering software to limit access to inappropriate Web sites, the use of this software is not a guarantee that children will not be able to access violent, sexual or otherwise inappropriate materials. By granting permission for their children to use the Internet at school, parents accept responsibility for any information their children may access.

Students who wish to use school computers or to use personal computers at school must comply with the guidelines above. Students who do not adhere to these guidelines will lose their computer privileges for the remainder of the school year. Repeated violations may result in permanent loss of computer privileges. Parents will be expected to make restitution to the school for any damaged software, hardware or peripheral equipment.
